

HANOI GOLFING

9Days 8Nights 5Rounds
(Tour ref.: A&P-2-9A)

Day 1: Arrival Hanoi

Our representative/tour guide will meet and greet you at the airport. You will visit the city's outstanding tourist sites: Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and the political area of Vietnam, learn about the history and the country's constitution . One-pillar Buddhist Pagoda and The Temple of Literature (Confucius temple), a brief learning about two most popular religions in Vietnam. You also walk through the lively streets in the old quarter of Hanoi. Evening highlight will be Water Puppet Performance – the unique form of Vietnamese art derived from wet-rice civilization in South East Asia Drive to your hotel. Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 2: Golfing @ King's Island Golf and Country Club (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, we travel to the King's Island Golf and Country Club - the first golf course ever built in North Vietnam is an exclusive golf and recreational resort, incorporating two 18-hole golf courses consisting of Lake Side and Mountain View, club house facilities. We spend 1 round of 18 holes at Lakeside course which was designed by American Golf Course Architect, Robert McFarland, who has been involved in designing championship golf courses around the world including Mission Hills California. Nature herself has created a superb setting for this very challenging 6,454 Yards, Par 72 course. Transfer back to hotel. Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 3: Hanoi-Halong Bay-Hanoi (B,L)

Today we depart for Halong Bay, we go through the scenic countryside. The wondrous Halong Bay is truly one of Vietnam's most impressive scenic sights. Heading out of the town we embark on a boat for an exploration of the legendary Halong Bay. This exciting five hour cruise will provide us a fantastic view of the picturesque scenery blending with the sky and some 3,000 limestone islands rising amazingly from the clear and emerald water. The limestone karsts formations are littered with beaches, grottoes and beautiful caves. Along the way we will anchor for a leisurely swim in a secluded cove and an enjoyable visit to one of the many hidden grottoes beneath towering cliffs. Transfer back to Hanoi. Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 4: Golfing @Phoenix Golf Club (B)

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy a round 18 hole of golf @ Phoenix Golf Club , the course is located 38km away from Hanoi city, it has a beautiful view beyond description so it's called Halong Bay of the land. Drive back to hotel. Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 5: Flight Hanoi- Ho Chi Minh City Tour (B)

Proceed 2hours flight to Ho Chi Minh City - still fondly referred to as Saigon by the locals, "The Pearl of the Orient" still retains a charm reminiscent of its French-European heritages like the President Palace, War Museum. Notre Dame Catholic Church, City Hall or Post Office in the midst of rapid commercialization of the country's busiest city. The city promises an endless fascination for tourists wanting to explore Vietnam's rich 4,000-year history. Overnight at hotel in Hochiminh

Day 6: Golfing @ Vietnam Golf and Country Club -Cu Chi Tunnels

Enjoy an 18-hole round of golf in the morning at the East/West golf course in the Vietnam Golf and Country Club followed by an afternoon visit to the Cu Chi Tunnels. Return and overnight in Hochiminh city.

Day 7: Gofing @Song Be Golf Resort in Binh Duong(B)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Binh Duong. Song Be Golf Resort is only 35 minutes drive from the city center and Tan Son Nhat Airport. Our 18-hole golf course was Vietnam's first of international standard, and received an official USGA course rating in September 1995. Operational since early 1994, this par 72 resort-style layout offers an interesting mix of truly challenging holes. Featuring numerous lakes, coconut palms and gently undulating greens, the course, which is over 6,300 meters at its longest, provides an enjoyable test for golfers of all levels. Play 1 round of 18 holes. Afternoon back to Hochiminh City. Overnight in Hochiminh

Day 8: Golfing @Longthanh Golf Club (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Long Thanh. Situated about 40 minutes from the center of Saigon on the Vung Tau spur road, we currently offer a superb thirty-six holes, each course offers panoramic views over the surrounding countryside to Saigon in the west and rural landscape in all directions. Play 1 round of 18 holes. Afternoon back to Hochiminh City. Overnight in Hochiminh City.

Day 9: Hochiminh Departure

Free at leisure by your own until we transfer you to the airport for departure flight. End of service.
